






DATES OF THE GAMES

Period of the Games has been determined considering the following elements

- Meteorology,
- Health,
- School and University times,
- Other international sporting events,
- · Celebrations and important events in Senegal.
- Consultation has taken place with ANOC and the IFs on the YOG programme
- Opening Ceremony and first day of competition Saturday 31st October
- 31st October 13th November 2026
- Further work and analysis of the YOG Schedule to be done in relation to;
 - Sport/event programme & formats





SPORT PROGRAMME

DAKAR 2026 YOUTH OLYMPIC GAMES

- Biggest/largest programme in the history of the Olympic Games and Youth Olympic Games with 35 sports confirmed
- Current size of the YOG Programme
 - **35** sports
 - 41 disciplines
 - **247** events
 - 4676 athlete quotas
 - 14 days of competition
- Sports on the programme to remain untouched but important to review disciplines and events to fit with the local context and sporting landscape.
- IOC IFs and Dakar 2026 discussions to take place from July 2023
- Aim for a meaningful delivery with less to focus on but more to achieve.





INTERNATIONAL FEDERATIONS ENGAGEMENT





CONTEXT:

- Dakar 2026 and IOC reviewing the Edition Plan
- IOC Sports & Dakar YOGOC to review structure and engagement with IFs between now to December 2023 to develop a high-level engagement plan



- Recent site visit from IFs important for IFs to see the reality of the project and explore opportunities for optimisation
- Simplicity is key and focus effort on longer term legacy and opportunities compared to "mini-Olympic Games"

OPPORTUNITIES FOR NATIONAL FEDERATIONS



- As part of the overall YOG legacy, sport plays a key role as the Youth Olympic Games aim to maximise sporting opportunities for the local youth, host city, region and country for sporting innovation and the development of their respective sports in the host country
- Important for NFs to focus on the preparation of the national teams and athletes to compete during the YOG
- Legacy opportunities for NFs to be explored beyond athlete selection and focus on technical officials, volunteers, equipment, education and overall promotion of sport between now and October 2026







KIDS OLYMPIC SKILLS



Project Summary:

"Kids Olympic Skills" is an activity aimed at promoting a series of sports among young people in Senegal by giving them the chance to try these sports. The ones chosen will differ from one geographic location to another, with the aim of presenting sports most relevant to the children depending on their economic and social environment.

In addition, this activity will be an opportunity to launch a nationwide project which will give each Senegalese child the chance to learn to swim. This will also provide the chance to promote nautical and water sports.

Target Groups:

Senegalese children aged 6 to 18

- Sports groups and federations
- Senegalese sports movement generally

Timetable: Launch in October 2022 and continued implementation until 2026.
